Overview

Dollar Academy, the Sunday Times' Scottish Independent Secondary School of the Year 2018, is one of Scotland's largest and best performing schools. Founded in 1818, Dollar Academy is the world's oldest co-educational day and boarding school. John Hughes, Director of IT, is responsible for the the school's 900+ desktops and end-point devices deployed across the institution's 1,440+ employees and students.

The Challenge

Running a combined Windows 7 and Windows 10 environment, across both physical and VMware Horizon 7.5.0 VDI desktops, had created a number of issues that were causing loss of user productivity. As Mr Hughes explained, "Profiles were excessively large and we were struggling to find a way to remove the build up of cookies. We also needed to reduce login times, plus we required one roaming profile between Windows 7 and Windows 10 along with being able to use Outlook in cache mode for roaming profiles." Further, Mr Hughes needed to be able to manage the deployment of network printers and applications across both VDI and physical PCs, while achieving a much-needed reduction in VDI base-image size.

The Solution

Having looked at various options, including scripts, removing roaming profiles, ThinApp and App Volumes, Mr Hughes took the advice of Liquidware partner Capito and undertook a product demonstration of Liquidware ProfileUnity with FlexApp. He explained, "We had a tight window for deployment, so we went with Capito's recommendation, as they are a trusted source and preferred IT support provider for the school.
